F. McBeath of the East Florida Seminary made an address to the teachers Friday night and had a crowded house. The Marion county teachers present from Dunnellon were Principal Robert Lovell, Miss Daisy Milligan and Miss Ruby Brassell. Miss Mattie Gamble, a charming young lady of Dunnellon, accompanied them. The people of Inverness entertained the teachers and visitors most hospitably.

He has quite a grove of young pecan trees, and says in his estimation they are preferable to orange trees for profit.


