

## KAISER'S MEN MAY REACH THE COAST

### CAPTURE OF ANTWERP ADDS WEIGHT TO THEIR COLUMNS

#### LOOKS LIKE THE GERMANS MAY SUCCEED IN BREAKING DOWN ALLIED LEFT

Paris, Oct. 13.—Pierce fighting on the right wing of Germany's great army in France indicates that troops have already arrived from Antwerp. A considerable number have also reinforced the Germans against Ghent.

#### COMING NEARER TO THE ENGLISH CHANNEL

The fighting is getting nearer and nearer the English channel. German cavalry is advancing in front of the infantry and field artillery.

#### FALL OF GHENT REPORTED

The fighting at the north is being carried on with unprecedented violence. Ghent is reported fallen, leaving only Bruges and Ostend in the hands of the allies.

#### FEARFUL CONDITIONS ALONG THE LINE OF BATTLE

The battle line is now practically 250 miles long and an unspeakable condition prevails along the month-old battle line. The sickening stench is nauseating to many of the troops.

#### GERMANS TAKE LILLE AGAIN

Paris, Oct. 13.—It is officially announced that the Germans have captured Lille but the French made some progress between Arras and Albert and also at center of the battle front.

The censorship is tighter than ever.

#### AVIATORS THREW BOMBS INTO OSTEND

Ostend, Oct. 13.—Three German aeroplanes circles over Ostend last night, dropping two bombs. The population is fleeing panic stricken to England. The Germans have occupied Ghent and are proceeding westward.

#### MAKING HEADWAY IN CENTER FLANKING MOVEMENT

Paris, Oct. 13.—The German capture of Lille was effected with 40,000 troops, indicating that the Germans are gaining in their counter-flanking movements against the allies left wing, and the kaiser's troops will now sweep rapidly to the coast.

The French claim gains between Arras and Albert, southwest of Lille, and at center of the battle front in the region of Berry and Au Bac.

#### DEATH OF AN ITALIAN STATESMAN

Rome, Oct. 13.—It is reported that Foreign Minister Sangiuliano is dead.

## BATTLE OF MAN BIRDS

### ARMIES WATCHED THE DEADLY STRUGGLE OF FRENCH AND GERMAN AVIATORS

Paris, Oct. 13.—An aerial battle, fought a thousand feet high, was witnessed and is confirmed by troops of both armies. It resulted in the wrecking of the German aeroplane and killing the aviator. Another German machine escaped.

Washington, Oct. 13.—Senators from the cotton growing states today prepared to submit a Senate amendment to the war tax bill, designed to aid the farmers in the war crisis.

## GERMANS CLAIM WESTERN POLAND

### SAY THEY HAVE DRIVEN RUSSIANS OUT OF DISPUTED TERRITORY

Berlin, via Amsterdam, Oct. 13.—It is officially stated that the Germans are masters of all Russian Poland west of the Vistula river. It is admitted that the Germans lost some ground to the Russians in the territory near East Prussian frontier, but it is declared this is of no consequence as they never planned to occupy Suwalki.

Germans claim to have conquered the West Vistula province, roughly estimated at over 7,000 square miles, including a number of important manufacturing towns.

#### THE RESTLESS ZAPATA

### And His Partisans Give People of Mexico City a Scare

Mexico City, Oct. 13.—An attack Saturday night at San Angelo and other suburbs of Mexico City by adherents of Emeliano Zapata caused a reign of terror in the capital until today. The suspense was relieved when it was officially announced that Zapata's followers had agreed to cease all firing pending the peace conference between the northern and southern constitutionalists generals at Aguas Calientes. The troubles may be satisfactorily adjusted.

#### SUNK A RUSSIAN SHIP

### Another German Submarine Got in Its Deadly Work

Petrograd, Oct. 13.—An official announcement says that on October 11 the Russian armored cruiser Pallada was torpedoed in the Baltic Sea by a German submarine and sank with all her crew.

#### SUPERIORITY OF ENGLISH AIR SHIPS

### Is Claimed by Experts Who Have Watched Them in Operation

London, Oct. 12.—"The English aeroplanes have proved to be more than equal to those of the Germans," says the Paris correspondent of the Times. "Especially success has been

secured with the new type of English aeroplane called the 'Chaser,' which is capable of developing a speed of 150 miles an hour and can rise from the ground at a sharp angle.

"The German anti-airship guns are so effective that it is unwise for the British or French aviators to fly lower than 600 feet from the ground.

"An air-man when under fire has to keep up continual glides, sharp turns and evolutions in order to prevent the enemy from getting accurate aim. Looping the loop, however is strictly forbidden."

## AUSTRIANS ARE CHASING THEM OUT

### AND SAY THEY ARE CLOSE ON THE HEELS OF THE FLYING ENEMY

Vienna, Oct. 13.—The Austrian general staff states that the Russian retreat in Galicia and Russian Poland continues, with the Austro-Germans in pursuit.

## BACKBONE OF TURKEY BRACED

### BY FALL OF ANTWERP, AND SHE MAY DECLARE WAR ON BRITAIN

Berlin, Oct. 13.—The British ambassador in Constantinople ordered all women to leave the embassy today.

The Russian Black Sea squadron is sailing southward. A crisis is on in Turkey.

#### REBELLION IN SOUTH AFRICA

### Col. Maritz and His Partisans Try to Set Up a Government of Their Own

London, Oct. 13.—A Reuter dispatch from Capetown says that it is officially announced that the troops under Colonel Maritz, northwestern Cape Province, rebelled and martial law has been proclaimed throughout the Union of South Africa.

## TAKING A TERRIBLE TOLL

### OVER 120,000 KILLED, DISABLED AND MISSING IN PRUSSIAN RANKS ALONE

Berlin, Oct. 13.—An official statement today admits that the Prussian army corps alone has lost 123,000 officers and men killed, wounded and missing since the war started.

## SOLDIERS SHIVER

### GERMANS IN POLAND OBLIGED TO STRIP DEAD TO CLOTHE THEMSELVES

Petrograd, Oct. 13.—The defeat of the Austro-German army advancing on Dandominers, Russian Poland, on the Vistula, northeast of Cracow, is officially announced today.

The Germans lost an entire division in an engagement believed to be near the Vistula, Galicia.

It is reported from the front that the Germans are short of clothing, the uniforms being stripped from the dead to clothe others.

German General Gorst is reported killed.

## PROGRAMS IN POLAND

### GERMANS SAY RUSSIANS ARE SPARING TIME FROM WAR TO PERSECUTE THE JEWS

Berlin, Oct. 13, by wireless to Sayville. (Official)—The Russians have sent two regiments to suppress a mutiny among Siberian reservists. Programs have occurred in Besarabia and Poland.

## ADVANCING ON OSTEND

### THREE GERMAN ARMIES CONVERGING ON THE TOWN

#### BEGINS TO LOOK LIKE INVADERS WILL ENTIRELY OVERWHELM BELGIANS

London, Oct. 13.—That the Germans are rapidly shifting their forces in an attempt to trap the Belgian army and British forces that assisted in the defense of Antwerp, is indicated by dispatches from three different sources today. Two showed that the Germans are moving rapidly westward from Antwerp and a third reported strong German detachments moving northwest, all apparently to converge at Ostend.

An unconfirmed report today says the Germans are bombarding Bruges, fourteen miles southeast of Ostend. A heavy German force is concentrated around Ypres.

The French admit the Germans captured Roye.

## HAVE TO LEAVE HOME

### BELGIAN GOVERNMENT MAY REMOVE FROM OSTEND TO HAVRE

Bordeaux, Oct. 13.—It is officially announced that the Belgian government will be transferred from Ostend to Havre, France, some of the officials having already arrived at Havre.

#### COSSACKS WERE NOT CRUEL

Russians in Galicia Behaved Better Than Their Adversaries Expected

London, Oct. 13.—A dispatch to the Reuter Telegraph Company from Amsterdam says that a telegram received from Vienna states that the Russians in Galicia along the Vistula are pursued by the German troops. Many towns which a few days ago were held by the Russians, are now under German command. It was said that the Russians did not behave so badly as the authorities expected. Even the Cossacks conducted themselves humanely.
