TAKES PERSONAL CHARGE. Gov. Foraker Will Run His Own Committee and Distribute the Bootie. COLUMBUS, O., Sept. 18. That Gov. J. B. Foraker is greatly alarmed over the situation, notwithstanding the hypocritical love making at Springfield is evidenced by the fact that he has taken personal charge of the Republican State Executive Committee, and will from this time on not only direct all its work but personally supervise the distribution of the ample campaign funds. This was necessitated by a hitch in the committee's opening work. The partisans of McKinley and Sherman about the committee were assuming too many prerogatives, which nettled Chairman Kurtz and also offended Gov. Foraker. Moreover, a large number of Gov. Foraker's wealthy friends refused to contribute with any degree of liberality to the funds of the committee, if any one other than Foraker controlled their disposition. This brought matters to a crisis, and Gov. Foraker after a long conference with the chairman, took entire control of the Committee, and will constantly direct its work, staying in Columbus as much of his time as the exigencies of the campaign will permit. As soon as word to this effect was sent out the moneyed friends of Gov. Foraker signified their immediate readiness to furnish one of the largest campaign funds ever disbursed in Ohio, and it is already being sent in. Sherman's and McKinley's wealthy backers will probably not contribute heavily, but there will be plenty of money, notwithstanding. HERE is Senator Brice's definition of sound money: "A currency of which all dollars, whether paper or silver or gold, shall be interchangeable and equally good for their normal par in the hands of every man everywhere." Isn't that sound? MR. STEPHEN BROPHY, of Toledo, was in the city Tuesday last, looking after his political fences. Mr. B. is a candidate for State Senator from this district and he goes to the Ottawa convention with a large following from his county. Should he secure the nomination he will be a strong candidate and pull many votes from the Republicans, as he is quite popular at his home with all classes. THE Napoleon township caucus on Saturday last was fairly well attended. Thos. Conway was made Chairman and Gale B. Orwig Secretary. On motion a committee of five was appointed to select county and senatorial delegates. The committee consisted of the following: M. Donnelly, Theo. Damman, O. Parker, A. F. Rafferty and H. R. Rohrs. The report of the committee was adopted and the caucus stood adjourned. The list of delegates selected will be found in another column. ARTICLES of manufacture that were formerly imported are now being shipped from this country. The outward cargo of one of the big line ships consisted largely of machinery—168 cases—and of hardware, bicycles, etc. The course of trade is being reversed and American manufactures are now finding markets abroad for their wares. The new tariff is proving itself the friend of American industry and the boon of American labor. WHEN the Democratic platform of 1892 said "We hold to the use of both gold and silver as the standard money of the country and to the coinage of both gold and silver without discriminating against either metal or charging for mintage" it uttered plain, straight, sound and constitution doctrine. Bimetallism has nothing to do with the ratio save as a matter of policy, but it has all to do with the doctrine that all coined money shall be free and equal. The ratio is to be fixed by congress. We believe that the present ratio is the best because it perpetuates all the dollars now coined, and when free coinage is the law and the policy of the government the commercial value and the coinage value of the two metals will be one and the same thing.—Cleveland Plain Dealer. Why are the people of Ohio so heavily burdened with taxation? This question is repeatedly asked. It is more largely the fault of reckless or corrupt legislation than anything else. This is shown by the following tabulation, compiled from the Auditor of State's reports, where the bulk of it is reported, and from the city and county records, where a vast sum appears which is never reported to the Auditor of State for obvious reasons. Notably in the counties of Hamilton, Cuyahoga, Lucas, Montgomery and others containing large cities heavily bonded, immense sums of local bonded indebtedness are unreported to the Auditor of State. Nearly all of the bonded indebtedness given below was authorized and created by a species of vicious special legislation, intended to evade the constitutional safeguards originally intended for the protection of the taxpayer. How utterly reckless succeeding Legislatures have been is best shown by the following table giving the amount of the grand duplicate in millions, the total amount of local bonded indebtedness, and the total amount of taxes, State, county and municipal, collected for seven years.
