Frozen Desserts

Even without an ice cream freezer some of the choicest of frozen desserts are an easy possibility for the home table. All the equipment necessary is an airtight mould or pail with closely fitted cover and an outer receptacle to hold equal parts of ice and salt. The flavored cream is placed in the inner receptacle and left in the ice pack for three or four hours, when it will be found to the right consistency to serve in individual cases or to use as the centre of a bombe or fancy form of ice cream, the outer layer being of a different mixture, frozen more solidly in a regulation freezer.
