

# ASSEMBLY HALL IN ALAMOGORDO NEARLY FINISHED

## Plan Is to Open New Building on New Year's Day With Big Celebration; Otero County Commissioners Meet.

Special Correspondence to Morning Journal. Alamogordo, N. M., Dec. 21.—Work on the assembly hall and amusement pavilion is now nearing completion. The building is enclosed with the exception of the hanging doors and placing of the windows, and all the material which will be required is now on the ground. The pavilion is one 100 feet, without a pillar or post in the interior, with a floor of the finest maple. Thirty-six big windows, four double doors and one single door, will make the place almost as cool in summer as an arid zone. It was given provision from the sum of \$100,000 of the county and state aid.

# BOARD FAVORS NAVY EQUAL TO THE STRONGEST

## Annual Report of Body Headed by Admiral Deyou Outlines Comprehensive Plan of Construction.

BY MORNING JOURNAL SPECIAL LEADERS WIRE. Washington, Dec. 21.—The American navy should be "equal to the most powerful in the world," the report of the board headed by Admiral Deyou says. The annual report of the board, made public today, states that the navy in July last in answer to the following proposition, propounded by Secretary Daniels when the administration reached its decision in favor of a complete re-organization of the navy: "What the navy must be in the future in order to stand as an equal to the most powerful and most practically serviceable."

# MAIL SEIZURES CAUSE TROUBLE TO THE NEUTRALS

## England Is Now Interfering With Letters and Packages Between Sweden and United States.

London, Dec. 21 (AP)—The Swedish steamship Stockholm, formerly the Holtan-American liner Potomac, which was recently taken into harbor in the British dominions while bound from Gotthenburg for New York, was released after some of her mail had been removed. This is the first case of the removal of mail from a vessel en route from Sweden to the United States, although some time ago the Swedish government complained that American-bound mail from Sweden contained by way of England had been opened in the United States.
