Carnard & Brady are now laying the foundation for eight buildings in the west side of the town. These buildings are intended for rent, and there is no doubt that they will command good figures.

The cellar which Johnson & Stone-man have put in the rear part of their property on 28th street, and which they intend to use for the storage of vegetables, is being finished.

We regret to note the death, at Miles City, of Harvey McElrath, the son of our esteemed friend Major McElrath.

The railroad water works were completed on Monday evening and the first locomotive took water there then.
