Poisoning squirrels is the order of business with Washington farmers. These pests are being killed by thousands.

Notwithstanding the fire and its attendant losses, the people of Weiser, Idaho, have resolved to go on with the arrangements already begun for celebrating the Fourth of July and will celebrate even in a grander style than that first contemplated.
