ABOUT THE OLYMPIC CLUB

A Letter From the Captain in Which Some Valuable Pointers Are Given—The Game for Thanksgiving Day.

The Butte football team left over the Union Pacific yesterday afternoon for Denver, where they will play the Denver Athletic club's eleven on Saturday afternoon.

Manager Silvers received the following letter yesterday from H. P. Taylor, the captain of the Olympic club, in which he gives some interesting information about the players and their positions:

"San Francisco, Nov. 15, 1895. 'D. Gay Silvers, Manager Butte Football Team, Butte, Mont.

"Sir: Answering your request relating to information concerning our football eleven, enclosed find newspaper clippings and a regime of the entire team. Pictures, etc., will follow. George Smith, commonly called 'Pete,' received his football education at Berkeley university, where he played guard for two seasons on the 'varsity' eleven.

"As for myself, the term of endearment the boys have for me is 'Husky,' and not being willing to throw bouquets at myself, you will have to spare me. I am not certain that this will be the exact line-up during our sojourn in your city, but near enough, at any rate.

"F. A. Kingston, nicknamed 'Fat,' is comparatively a new man, receiving his first football knocks last year with the Olympics' second eleven. Although but 20 years old he weighs 230 pounds, not as fat as the above name would imply, but with hard, solid muscle.

"W. A. Sexton, better known as 'Sandow,' will play right tackle. His football knowledge and experience has been confined to the past five years with the Olympic and Reliance clubs, and for a sure tackler and a 'never-say-die' player.

"Robert Porter, alias 'Chronic Bob,' and destined to play right tackle, is one of the best all-round players of the coast and the best football authority. His football career dates back to 1880, when he played on the Pennsylvania's second eleven against Harvard.

"Hunter Harrison, who will hold down left end, has been playing football for four seasons. He is titled 'Gecko.' Mr. Harrison is a conscientious player and is doing some remarkably good work thus far in his old position. His age is 24 and weight 170 pounds.

"Virgil Nahl, known as the 'Little Un,' is about 23 years old and weighs about 160 pounds. Although miniature in size, he is one of the most agile and deliberate players on the team. He seems to be in every play and under every scrimmage, and very much similar in style of play to Eddie Sherman, the famous Berkeley captain and right end.

"F. Sharratt is the only new man on the team, and is rapidly developing into a quarter-back. He is active and strong, and a fine tackler. His passing of the ball is superb, but his lack of experience and knowledge is a great drawback. He weighs 155 pounds and is 19 years of age.

"L. A. Hilborn, the famous mile, half-mile, 440 and 220-yard runner, formerly of Berkeley, is trying for the position of right half. Mr. Hilborn has played in like capacity on the 'varsity' team the past two seasons, but owing to removal to this city he has joined hands with the Olympic club—their loss our gain. 
