signs as if they were thus insured by the officer on guard was summoned by the inside of a neighboring cell who reported a disturbance in the Cheyennes' compartment. The officer proceeded to the cell, looked through the small air hole in the door and seeing the smaller of the prisoners standing by the window asked him what was the matter. The prisoner answered that everything was all right, that he and his friend, were both well, pointing as he spoke to his friend crouched against the door. The officer did not enter but when he returned and looked through the aperture in the door he saw the little Indian hanging by a short leather strap from the window bar. Summoning help the door was forced open when the whole scheme of the suicide was apparent at a glance. The only article about the clothing of the prisoners at all available for their purpose was a short, narrow leather thong worn by one of them as a belt; and with this they both managed to accomplish their purpose. The big fellow took the lead. His hands had first been tied to his thigh after which, possibly with the help of his companion, he was hanged to the iron window bar, making while strangling the noise that had attracted attention. The little fellow placed the dead body of his friend in a sitting posture against the door, where he was "all right" at the time of the officer's visit, and then prepared to follow to the happy hunting grounds the shade of his companion who had just died before his eyes. To do this he arranged a slip knot by which his hands could be inserted in a noose then drawn tight and securely fastened to his thigh. In this way he took precautions against weakening at the last moment, as well as against involuntary exertions made after his strong will would have ceased to act. The window bar was only four feet from the floor, but having securely fastened his hands he allowed his feet to slide out toward the ring to which he was chained. In this way his body was thrown into a slanting position, resting partly on the floor, in a part suspended by the thong, and in this posture he remained until he died. The death thus inflicted was to escape the disgrace of a public execution. The annals of the heroic ages contain no record to surpass this act of two obscure Cheyennes in slowly strangling themselves to ward a public disgrace from their tribe.
