Local News.

From the Daily Thursday.
The Robert Emmet Literary Association announce a ball for Thanksgiving night.

Vice-President Oakes, of the Northern Pacific railroad, has arrived at Billings on his way west.

A private telegram received in Butte yesterday from a prominent business man of this city, who left here a bachelor, says: "Will arrive in Butte Thursday evening, accompanied by my wife." Guess who it is.

Marshall L. P. Smith received a letter yesterday from the Superintendent of Pinkerton's detective force, who thanks him for efficient aid rendered to Detective McElhin in the capture of the Kewanee bank robber, and assures him that the country will be repaid should any Butte crooks come that way.

A large delegation of Masonic and other friends of the late Hon. Thomas M. Powers, will take the train for Deer Lodge this morning to attend the funeral obsequies. The train is a special, which will be run through to Deer Lodge, leaving Butte at 9 a. m. and returning at 8:45 p. m. The fare for the round trip will be \$3.25.

In the District Court yesterday Michael Fisher was found guilty of assault with intent to kill, and his punishment fixed at one year in the Territorial prison. Henry Mitchell and Andrew J. Eddy, convicted of petit larceny, were sentenced to sixty days in the County Jail, the first and last ten days on a diet of bread and water.

The Fire Brigade.

The meeting of the fire brigade adjourned last night without transacting any business. The fire brigade has made a definite proposition to the City Council to furnish 1,000 feet of hose, and more if necessary, providing the Council will supply them with a suitable hose house and watch tower. The brigade also propose to furnish a fire-alarm bell weighing not less than 1,000 pounds, providing a suitable belfry is furnished by the city. The hose and bell offered by the brigade will cost them about \$2,200. It was expected the Council would take some action upon the matter last night, but as the Council did not take up the subject last night the brigade adjourned subject to call.

A Brutal Wife Beater.

Charles P. Howard was arrested last night by Marshal Smith, charged with wife beating. Persons living in the neighborhood of Howard's house, near the Morning Star mine, say he has been in the habit of abusing his wife and a ten-year-old son most shamefully. It was ascertained that when Howard works at all, he is a stevedore, but that recently he has done no work, spending his time alternately between drinking bad whiskey and abusing his family, while his wife worked for her own and his support. Mrs. Howard has been a nurse in the family of H. G. Valiton, Esq., and is spoken of by those who know her as a very respectable and industrious woman. Yesterday morning Howard being on one of his drunken sprees, made threats which frightened his wife, and she sought protection at Mr. Valiton's residence. Howard made several attempts to enter the house during the afternoon, but was ordered away by Mr. Valiton who finally told him if he came again he would have him arrested, and Howard promised not to annoy the family further. Soon afterward Mrs. Howard saw her husband go up town, and thinking to take advantage of his absence, she went home to procure some necessary wearing apparel. Howard saw her and followed her into the house, where he made a savage assault upon the defenseless wife, striking terrific blows with clenched fists upon her head and face, throwing her to the floor and kicking her till she was almost senseless, and her clothing torn in shreds. The neighbors hearing her cries rushed in and rescued the woman from the infuriated brute. He was unable to procure bail last night and will probably have time behind the bars to reflect upon his success in life as a determined and courageous wife beater.

City Council.
