LONDON, June 19.—The negotiations between the Liberals and Conservatives are proceeding through the medium of the Queen. The Marquis of Salisbury urges that if the Redistribution of Seats bill is finally passed the Conservatives will be deprived of the constitutional privilege of appealing to the country, should the Liberals refuse to accept the bill as a public business. Therefore, Salisbury, after taking the best legal advice on the subject, has decided not to allow the bill to pass into a law until further consideration has been had. It is impossible for the bill to come into operation before November. Lord Salisbury insists upon having the Liberals pledge themselves not to willfully obstruct the Conservative legislation.
