DID WE FIGHT FOR IT?

In his speech at Dillon Tom Carter said that China has been living almost exclusively upon rice, and was not open to our commerce until a few years ago, but that now a vast amount of American flour is consumed in China, and that the largest order ever given for American flour came from China only last year.

What of it? Tom Carter said that in defending the republican waste of \$650,000,000 to conquer the Philippines and their market. We didn't have to shoot any Chinaman to induce them to buy American flour. We did not have to establish a military government in China to get a market for American flour. No American warships have been sent to china, no American military posts have been established in China to get Chinese trade.

THEY OUGHT NOT TO.

Col. Sam Gordon, a Tom Carter officeholder, asks in his Miles City Journal if the Democratic leaders suppose the voters are going to forget the history of the past eight years.

Some voters may forget it, but they ought to remember it. They ought to remember some of the history of the Roosevelt administration, which in three years had spent \$211,000,000 more than the McKinley administration spent in four years, and \$880,000,000 more than the last Cleveland administration spent.

What is there to show for that awful waste of money. Nothing but a larger army and a larger navy, and we don't need either one, for the army and navy were big enough

before.

The voters ought to remember that when a shameful scandal came to light in the postoffice department, the Republicans in congress refused to investigate it. They ought to remember that Mr. Cortelyou, the man who as a cabinet officer had got the secrets of the criminal trusts, was made chief fat-fryer of the republican campaign, and thus put in a position where he could "hold up" every trust in the country for campaign funds.

No; the voters ought not to forget.


Even if the people have but do not use, the right of initiative, that right remains in their hands to enable them to get legislation they want when a legislature refuses to listen to the demands of the people.
