## COUNCIL MEETS

The city council met in special session at the city hall Thursday night, all the aldermen being present except Alderman Young.

The sidewalk committee reported regarding placing the sidewalk in the Peterson block on a grade, which report was accepted.

Bids from Marcoe & Swanson, H. W. Gross and P. H. Brader were received for putting steam heating apparatus in fire house. The matter was referred to a committee.

The monthly report of Magistrate Pyper was read. The report showed a collection of fines for the past month of \$682.50. This is the largest revenue from that particular source ever paid into the city treasury.

Arrangements are being made to establish a public library in this city. Mayor Newman has been assisted by Mrs. Harvie in the matter and they hope to enlist the interest of enough citizens to equip a reading room with a good supply of books for the public's benefit. The city council voted to pay \$25 per month to be used toward defraying the expenses of the library. Mayor Newman has already been promised 500 books free of charge, by the State Library Federation, providing a board of 20 will be responsible for the wear and tear of the books.
