Jan. 12 John the Baptist. John 1, 19-34.

Our lesson for to-day considers one of the most remarkable characters of the bible—John the Baptist. In the first chapter of Luke one can learn of the events leading up to the birth of this wonderful man.

The Jews asked John three questions. First, whether he was the Christ, and John said he was not. Second, was he Elias, and John said "No."

Jesus gave testimony as to John the Baptist that of those born of women there had not risen one greater than he.

Superintendents and teachers are asked to bear in mind that Decision Day is coming early in February, and that it is time to begin training the children for making a public declaration that they are Christians.


