Sept. 27. A Temperance Lesson. Bible Text, Ias. 5, 11-23.

It is to be hoped that no one will have the thought on finding that the lesson of Sept. 27 is to dwell on the temperance question, that the topic is old and without interest. It is doubtful if there is a family in the land which has not suffered in some way from the too free indulgence in intoxicating liquors of some member, in the past twenty years. This being so, the temperance question is vital and requires prompt energetic action at the hands particularly Sunday School people. Intemperance is a form of sin, which will never be eradicated but this is no reason why those believing in purity and Godliness should relent their warfare upon it.

But yesterday we read of a man on trial for murder whose only but ineffectual defense was, that he was drunk. The judge said, what has been held hundreds of times, that intoxication is no defense for crime. There is confined in Mason City today a man we well know, held for murder who was notorious for hard drinking and consequent arousing of a temper which led him to do and say things of the most revolting nature. There is in this county today a professional man of marked ability, whom his friends are anxious to help and have done so, but he has thus far been unable to keep from losing his grip from drink at intervals. It is our earnest hope that his case has not gone too far, however. It is of course needless to go on reciting instances of this kind for the life experiences of every adult reader can supply plenty.

One of the lesson verses says that "Hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure" because of the wickedness coming from strong drink and its attendant evils, and every person knows this must be true. The lesson verses tell of those who follow strong drink, who give over to riotous feasting, and says these "regard not the work of the Lord, neither consider the operations of His hand."

A mighty indictment. Indeed it would be hard to find a more fearful arraignment of drink and drunkenness and what they lead to, than in the words of Isaiah written hundreds of years before the birth of Christ.

We can but arouse every parent to the urgency of early warning the little ones against the evils of drink and the sins that follow in its path. Jesus said it were better that a mill stone were hanged about one's neck and he were drowned, than that he offend one of the little ones, and it is certainly offending to fail to warn them early and often that they should abstain from liquor which will make them drunk. Do not say for a moment that temperance talk is stale. Let the drink curse strike your boy or girl and you will suddenly find you have vital interest in the total abstinence question. Teachers in the Sunday Schools should not fail to do their duty on temperance Sunday. The good work you may do in all your career as a teacher falls to the ground if the scholar becomes a confirmed drinker of intoxicants.
