Examinations Taking Place Looking to Granting Diplomas of Graduation from Schools

As is well known our present educational system for the rural schools, calls for a definite course of study, and graduation exercises with granting of diplomas on completion of eight years of successful work. In every rural school in the county where one scholar, or many, arrive where they can take the examination, this has been done. The county superintendent has been reading the papers of late. About thirty pupils wrote at the end of the winter term, and nearly all will pass. An average of 75 per cent and no study less than 65 per cent is required. In May another group will write, and it is expected that fully thirty will receive diplomas at the institute this summer.


