May 9. Paul at Antioch in Pisidia. Acts 13:13-16; 38-49.

Our last lesson told of the experiences of Paul and Barnabas on the island of Cyprus, as they were on their first missionary tour.

Arrived at Antioch they went to the Jewish synagogue, and were invited to talk, Paul who is said to have been a small, black eyed man, arose and gave the listeners an explanation of the Old Testament scriptures which attracted attention.

The Jews passed out making no comment on what they had heard. The Gentiles or those not Jews came forward to ask Paul to remain to talk to them the following Sabbath, and this he consented to do.

We call special attention to the words of Paul when he said that to his Jewish hearers was the word of salvation sent, and to his further declaration that he had judged themselves unworthy of the everlasting life offered them through faith in Jesus.

The ministers and representatives of the gospel of Jesus today assure the people that salvation through Christ is offered full and free. Each person of accountability must settle for themselves whether they judge themselves worthy eternal life.

Amendment To Articles of Incorporation of Nicholson Produce Company.
