



Christian Science and "Animal Magnetism."

To the Editor

Dear Sir:---Recent experiences among the membership of a Christian Science Church in New York City in which a teacher and practitioner of Christian Science has been debarred from practice and had her license to teach Christian Science cancelled because of alleged erroneous teachings and practices have given rise in the Press to considerable comment concerning the nature and character of what is known in Christian Science as "animal magnetism." It has been stated that certain persons in said church held the belief that through "animal magnetism" the so-called power of mortal thought could be used for the purpose of producing ill effects even to the extremity of death upon those persons who had incurred the displeasure of certain mag-

practitioners. As a matter of justice to Christian Science I desire to state emphatically that this is not in accordance with Christian Science teachings. To the Christian Scientist "animal magnetism" means merely "the specific term for error." (Science and Health Page 103). It is a technical term including all there is of evil. It is clearly recognized in Christian Science that all evil is necessarily mental and must therefore be overcome through a right thought process. Mrs. Eddy states in Science and Health: "In Christian Science man can do no harm, for scientific thoughts are true thoughts passing from God to man." And again, "You will also learn that in Science there is no transfer of evil suggestions from one mortal to another, for there is but one Mind, and this ever present omnipotent Mind is reflected by man and governs the entire universe." From the above quotations it is

readily seen that Christian Science denies the possibility of transference of evil thought in such a way as to injure another, in fact the Christian Scientist's protection consists in knowing for himself and for all mankind that these phases of erroneous mortal belief have no elements of truth in them and consequently no intelligence or power to operate in any way whatsoever.

It is the earnest, steadfast, consistent endeavor of every Christian Scientist to "overcome evil with good" and to practice in its completeness all that the Golden Rule includes and implies to deal justly and righteously with his fellow man.

It is impossible to ignore the fact that to ordinary experience evil exists to be and seems to be real and that to appearance and in belief mankind seems under certain circumstances to be susceptible to erroneous mental influences. Instead, however, of accepting this as fixed law Christian Science is teaching mankind how to protect themselves, how to deny and repudiate every suggestion of evil, how to nullify every discordant thought, how to overcome sin and disease. It recognizes but one Mind, but one intelligent activity, one law,

one power, one Principle governing the universe, even "God with us." Christian Science therefore cannot be used for any purpose other than good and for the establishment within the consciousness of each individual of the highest ideals of mortality and righteousness. Only that which is emphatically Christian, only that which embodies and includes parity and goodness can be found in the ranks of true Christian Scientists. It is the steadfast endeavor of every one who is entitled to bear this name to repudiate and eliminate from thought all that which "maketh and worketh a lie," and to prove to humanity that God alone governs. In order to do this it has been necessary at various times for the Christian Science Church to discipline those persons among its membership who in their lives of practice have given out a perverted and absolutely wrong thought concerning Christian Science and its teachings. This has been done in the case above referred to and will result in preserving the integrity of the Christian Science movement and will establish more firmly in the public thought that Christian Science stands emphatically for the purest and highest ideals of Christian rectitude.
