ORDINANCE NO. 259.

An Ordinance establishing and fixing the grades upon certain streets and parts of streets and street intersections and alleys in the city of Denison, Iowa.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of Denison, Iowa: Section 1. That the grades at the points named herein be established and fixed on the streets named hereinafter and at the elevation above the datum plane as established and fixed by the city council of the city of Denison, Iowa.
