MR. POWERS EXONERATED

The community was somewhat surprised on account of a report published in the Register of Des Moines a few days ago, as to what Mr. Powers, the representative from this county, may have said before the judicial committee of the house of representatives concerning a bill purporting to deal with the bolsheviks and I. W. W.s., and to prevent the red flag from being carried by such organizations in the state. The statement in the paper was to the effect that Mr. Powers opposed such legislation. It seems that this report was largely the invention of a young and inexperienced reporter who thought he was pulling off a scoop, and whose services have since been dispensed with by the newspaper which employed him. The following resolution adopted by the judicial committee before which the bill was pending seems to exonerate Mr. Powers from any blame: We understand that the newspapers in Des Moines have promised to correct the error. We are pleased to publish herewith the resolutions which seem to exonerate Mr. Powers from blame. What the paper said was so foreign to what was understood to be Mr. Powers' views that it naturally created surprise. We are always pleased to set right a citizen of the county who has been misrepresented.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, a misapprehension seems to have gotten abroad concerning what occurred at a meeting of this committee at a time when the committee substitute for the Fleuniken bill, otherwise known as the red flag bill, was under consideration. And whereas, accounts have been published which very seriously misrepresented what Mr. Powers said and the suggestions he made, and whereas, such reports do Mr. Powers very grave injustice. Therefore, be it resolved by the judicial committee of the house of representatives, that any account of what Mr. Powers said in connection with the bill which could possibly be construed as a defense of the red flag or the things for which it stands or the people who follow it is absolutely false and untrue, and that, on the contrary, Mr. Powers very vigorously condemned the red flag and all that it represents; that there was never any discussion or argument in the committee except as to the best method of dealing with what every member of the committee recognized as an undesirable condition in the state and nation. That the discussion had been going on in the committee for some little time before Mr. Powers said anything and what he said was by way of endorsement of other suggestions which had been made and was regarded by this committee as entirely proper and related to the vital features to be considered in a thorough deliberation of the bill under consideration. That Mr. Powers did not take the position that no legislation was needed with reference to the condition represented by the red flag, nor did he vote against recommending the bill to

the house for passage and any report that he did is incorrect and untrue. And be it further resolved, that it is the sense and judgment of this committee that Mr. Powers is not in any way in sympathy with the element connected with the so-called red flag and that he is just as anxious as any member of this committee to see the evil which it represents eliminated from this state and nation and we regard as unjust and unfair to Mr. Powers any suggestion to the contrary. Adopted Feb. 11, 1919.
