California.

California is 700 miles in length and about 200 in width. It has an area of 198,000 square miles, equal in extent to ten of the smaller Eastern States.

SOIL AND CLIMATE.

The soil and climate are eminently adapted to the growth of all the various kinds of fruits and vegetables. The harder fruits succeed well in all parts of the State, and along the southern coast oranges, lemons, figs, pineapples, and other species of tropical fruits are raised.

SCENERY.

California has the most beautiful and picturesque scenery of any State in the Union, and the most complete and varied views of Southern Italy, and the barren wastes of Northern Russia.

AGRICULTURE.

Of the 40,000,000 acres of land in the State only 1,000,000 are cultivated, and of the remaining 39,000,000 one-fourth has a very thin soil, or not fertile because of the presence of alkaline substances.

MINERAL PRODUCTIONS.

The chief industry of the State has been, and is, mining. From the mines almost every known mineral substance is procured, such as gold, silver, copper, quicksilver, coal, tin and lead.

HISTORICAL.

On the 5th day of June, A. D. 1578, Sir Francis Drake, an English nobleman, landed on the coast of California in latitude 38 north. Drake named this country "New Albion," the white cliffs reminding him of his native coasts and suggesting the happy compliment which his loyalty to Queen Elizabeth secured.
