THE CEDAR CREEK MINES.

An Open Letter to all Correspondents.

To the Editor New North-West:

I am in receipt of a large number of valuable letters (costing four bits each) from those seeking information about these mines. At the risk of being charged with neglect, I delayed answering until the period of doubt and uncertainty which enveloped the Cedar Creek Mines should pass away, and until developments should furnish facts as a basis for statements instead of hazardous mere opinion.

CEAR JUNCTION.

Of the towns, Cedar Junction lays claim to the position of supply-town for the mines. It is situated 8 miles from the river, at the junction of Cedar and Oregon gulches, and will probably be the permanent end of the wagon and stage road now about completed.

SHORT SUPPLIES.

It has four business firms who deal in general supplies; but just now, not a pound of tobacco, bacon, lard, or beans can be purchased, and so on to time during the winter has a full assortment of staples in the market, or the supply equal to the demand.

TO THE BOYS:

To my friends of the pick and shovel, a word—those who are out of diggings and intend coming here to prospect: If you want any of Cedar at the present time, hurry up before the snow melts, but bring your picks and apparatus, for you will need them.

In most of the claims the pay is found in from one to six feet of gravel. In canyons and narrow places it is confined to crevices in bed rock, the formation of the whole country being slate—sometimes a soft clay slate, but generally indurated and talcose mica.

THE PRESENT POPULATION.

The present population of the mines is about 1,000 people; the first female has yet to make her appearance in the diggings. There are no other persons in the diggings, save those of the Cedar Creek Mines.

ITS CAPABILITIES.

The prospected mines will support a population of full 5,000, of all occupations, when the season opens. At least such is the opinion of those here best informed. The estimate is not based on the basin above or the lower part of the creek proving profitable diggings. Should the paying ground be limited to the five and a half miles of the middle of the creek and the smaller prospected gulches putting in both above and below, we can daily estimate on a lively camp for a couple of seasons, when it will go the way of its predecessors.
