New Departure in Railroad Building. Six years ago the State Legislature took strong ground against granting any further subsidies to railroad corporations.

There are several counties in the State yet without railroad accommodation. The count counties of San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara and Ventura have long been waiting a connection with the Southern Pacific.

The committee decided upon building a narrow gauge railroad from tide water at Napa City to Clear Lake, by way of Berryessa valley. The committee proposes to adopt for building this road a system hitherto new to California, and with, we believe, but one exception new to the United States.

Early in the last session a similar proposal was made on behalf of Santa Barbara county. Colonel Hayne, the Assemblyman from that district, introduced a bill embodying just such a principle.


