Iowa Creameries Largest. The annual report of the state dairy commissioner has been completed and filed with Governor Cummins. The report shows that Iowa creameries are becoming fewer in numbers and larger, and that they have a larger average number of patrons and larger average output than those of the country generally. The number of creameries in Iowa was increasing a few years ago, but is now steadily decreasing. The report shows that a large number of creameries show a low average production per cow, especially the centralizing plants and those operated on the hand separator plan. The four largest centralizing plants reported 788 pounds per patron and 80 pounds per cow. Other creameries average up as high as, in one county 1,780 pounds per patron and 158 per cow. There are 25,388 hand separators in use in Iowa and 40 per cent of the entire butter output is made from hand separated cream. There are now 383 creameries using hand separators and 65 use them to the exclusion of other methods, as against only 38 exclusive last year. There are 61 receiving cream by rail as against 45 last year. The average creamery in Iowa has 998 cows and 130 patrons. Of the more than 720 creameries in the state, reports were received from 516, and they made 62,222,547 pounds of butter, sold for \$9,884,543 and of which 3,437,506 pounds were sold to patrons, sold in Iowa, 2,334,192 pounds; shipped out, 54,650,760 pounds. There are not as many creameries as last year, but the output was probably about the same as last year. The size of Iowa creameries has been increasing. Last year the average output was 97,770 pounds per creamery; this year it was 120,586 pounds. Commissioner H. R. Wright reports the entire cost of the dairy department including salaries, and of milk inspection in fourteen cities and expense of litigation, at \$8,634,431. Two assistant commissioners have been provided by law. The oleomargarine litigation is discussed in full, and statistics given as to renovated butter factories. The report is quite extensive.

International Exposition at Chicago. The fifth annual International Live Stock show will be held at Chicago from November 26 to December 3. It was conceded on all hands that last year's international was the greatest pure live stock show the world has ever seen. This year the exposition management has put forth stronger efforts to advert the exposition and it seems evident from this and from the large number of entries already made that the coming show will eclipse in educational value that of last year's.

The following number of cattle entries had been recorded November 2: Shorthorns, 236; Aberdeen Angus, 237; Herefords, 142; Galloways, 100; Red Polled cattle, 83; Polled Durhams, 62; grades and cross-breeds, 104. Sheep entries at the same time were: Shropshire, 155; Southdowns, 79; Oxford, 47; Hampshires, 69; Dorsets, 15; Cheviots, 60; Cotswolds, 73; Lincolns, 39; Leicesters, 41; Rambouilletes, 10. In addition to this 114 entries had been made in medium and long wool classes. Swine entries amounted to 430. The International Live Stock Exposition is becoming one of the greatest factors in live stock improvement of to-day. It is a great educational institution for the farm-
