CITIZEN DIAZ.

Deputy Jose Aspe in presenting Diaz's resignation as president, to the Mexican Chamber of Deputies, declared that the retiring President was the author of Mexican progress, but that the people of Mexico had progressed faster than he had realized.

Mexico has been afflicted with conditions somewhat similar to those which in recent years have burdened the industries of this country.

This country has permitted its large combinations of predatory wealth to limit production and fix prices much too long.

The swollen fortunes of this country have flowed over the Rio Grande, and one of Diaz's greatest mistakes was in welcoming the inflow.

If the resignation of Diaz brings peace to his country his retirement to private life will be recorded as one of the greatest acts of his life.

SENATOR CUMMINS' WASHINGTON COLLEGE ADDRESS.

In his speech to the graduating class of the Washington College of Law, Senator Cummins predicted that within the next ten years this country would either have to sternly regulate the big corporations or deal with a revolution.

In 1896 Senator Cummins was the Iowa member of the republican national committee. He had an office in the Equitable building in Des Moines only a few feet away from the office occupied by the writer.

In his speech to the graduates he said: "We are living in a period of revolution. There is danger in the spirit of discontented men who would rebel against the law."

"If there are wrongs, and there are, we should seek to remedy them through the law. The greatest problem that we are facing today, and the one upon which the American republic will be wrecked, if it ever is wrecked, is the question of the distribution of the vast wealth of the nation."

REDUCTION IN WOOL TAX.

Indications are that the Democratic House will reduce the tariff on raw wool by one-half. This would be carrying out the promise contained in the national democratic platform of 1908, which was that "gradual reductions should be made in such other schedules as may be necessary to restore the tariff to a revenue basis."

The consideration of the revenue needs of the government was what caused the bulk of the Democratic majority to decide upon cutting the raw wool duty in two.

The Democrats will strike every one of the iniquitous jokers from Schedule K and no duties on manufactures of wool will be above 50 per cent ad valorem.

The tax collected on manufactured wool last year amounted to \$20,000,000. The average rate under the Payne-Aldrich law amounts to the equivalent of 90 per cent ad valorem, and in the proposed Democratic bill this rate will be decreased one-half.
