

WHY SECRETARY WILSON FIRST?

As a result of the President's ex- eration of Doctor Wiley' many newspapers are clamoring for the removal of Secretary Wilson. The American people, without regard for party, are going to insist upon the dismissal of every public official who has interfered with the enforcement of the Pure Food Act, by plotting against the head of the Bureau of Chemistry. That much is true, or at least should be true, but why should the President commence by removing Secretary Wilson?

Attorney General Wickersham in a report to the President recommended that Doctor Wiley be permitted to resign, and by so doing identified himself with the plotters. A MARK HANNA CAMPAIGN IN CANADA.

SPECIAL WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENCE.

The democratic members of congress smile ordinarily these days when reference is made to President Taft's charge that the Democratic attempt to revise the tariff downward was not sincere, and that it merely was "playing politics." Their amusement springs from the remarkable coincidence of Mr. Taft's "vindication" of Dr. Wiley, and the start of his long trip through the west.

"Is it possible," they are asking, "that President Taft delayed his 'vindication' of Dr. Wiley until he could make use of it as a sort of favorable introduction to the people before going to meet them personally? And if this is true doesn't it favor more strongly of 'playing politics' than anything attempted by the Democrats?"

The President is known to have prepared his decision in the Wiley case several weeks ago, yet a word if it is given out until just before it starts into the troublesome and lousing West. It was frequently pointed out while the Moss investigating committee was in session that in view of the light thrown by that committee on the maladministration of the pure food law, the President could reach but one conclusion in the case against Dr. Wiley. After what the Moss probers developed the President would have invited political destruction had he dared to punish Dr. Wiley as Attorney General Wickersham on a popposumous usque to the slightest fear that Dr. Wiley would be separated from his job.

The Democrats will be sure, later on, to call attention to the fact that the Taft "vindication" of Dr. Wiley contains not one word of praise for that official, nor a single note of condemnation for the notorious McCabe. During the hearings before the Moss committee the investigators were frankly astounded at the McCabe revelations, and they all confessed that they didn't believe such tactics as his were possible outside of Russia, yet Mr. Taft finds no fault with McCabe.

The "vindication" of Dr. Wiley—who was already vindicated a thousand times over in the minds of the people—was simply a move on Mr. Taft's part to "beat the Moss committee to it." There is a strong suspicion, however, that when the Moss committee reports there will be not only a vindication for Dr. Wiley, but a scathing rebuke for McCabe and Dunlap.

In his "vindication" Mr. Taft said nothing about the future administration of the pure food laws, but it is well known that the democrats, after the shock they received at the Moss hearings, are determined to enact legislation which will make a continuation of the McCabe system impossible. They will insist that Dr. Wiley's hands be untied, and they will brush aside the McCabes and Dunlaps, the president having overlooked that important matter when he was bestowing his superfluous "vindication" upon Dr. Wiley. The Remsen board, with its questionable expenditure of \$250,000 will be done away with, and Dr. Wiley will get a real vindication from Congress that will mean something to him and the people whose interests he so valiantly protects, rather than one which serves no purpose except to provide a little favorable publicity for the President at a time when he needs something to calm the people before explaining to them why he failed to keep his promise to revise the tariff downward.
