

BOARD PROCEEDINGS

STATE OF IOWA, DELAWARE COUNTY, SS. Be it remembered that on this 13th day of Sept., 1915, it being the second Monday of said month, the Board of Supervisors met in regular session, all members and the Auditor being present.
