Beauty Poetry in Law Form.

As Judge Lindley's pamphlet on Codification is going through the press at the Herald office, enough is gathered from a glimpse of it, to show that he is doing his work in an analytical style, and in a manner that indicates a full comprehension of his subject, and a consciousness of the difficulties of illustrating what might seem to be abstract rules for Codification.

ILLUSTRATION OF RULE VIII.

"RULE VIII. Generalize and classify. Include many individuals in specific terms; many species in group terms, when it can be done with certainty.

"We commence the illustration of this Rule, by presenting Secs. 359 and 487, § 3, Penal Code, which are as follows:

"Sec. 359. (85.) Every person who marks or brands, alters, or defaces the mark or brand of any horse, mare, colt, jack, jennet, mule, bull, ox, steer, cow, calf, sheep, goat, hog, shoat, or pig belonging to another, with intent thereby to steal the same or to prevent identification thereof by the true owner, is punishable by imprisonment in the State Prison for not less than one nor more than five years.

"Sec. 487. (3.) When the property taken is a horse, mare, gelding, cow, steer, bull, calf, mule, jack, jenny, goat, sheep, or hog.

"In expression, we prefer to steer clear of:

"Bull, steer, ox, heifer, calf and cow, Hog, boar, barrow, shoat, pig and sow, Horse, stallion, gelding, colt and mare, Henny and mule—a hybrid pair, Ram, ewe, wether, lamb, white and black, Goats, male and female, young and old, All domestic beasts, yet untold; and call them all by their generic names, or put them all in one grand division and call them animals, and form the Section thus:

"(Sec. 359.) Every person who marks or brands, or alters or defaces a mark or brand on an animal, the property of another, with intent to steal the same, or to prevent its identification by the owner, is guilty of felony.

"If there is any question as to sufficient certainty in the phrase 'animal,' the property of another, we would define the word animal thus:

"The word animal, as used in the Code, unless a different meaning is apparent from the context, includes horses, cattle, hogs, sheep and goats; also, the young and male and female of each; also, mules and hinnys."

After discussing in a critical style the language of the Section, the following passage occurs:

"It is supposed, however, that the 'layman' understands these things, to a certainty, though the 'professional reader' may not. On this question of certainty, it will undoubtedly take a 'layman' to tell where 'hog' ends and 'shoat' begins, or where 'shoat' ends and 'pig' begins, when calf becomes a steer, when steer becomes an ox."

His, is evidently a novel mode of directing attention to the point. His poetry may be brutal, but his illustration is complete.

California Grain Fleet—Arrivals Outward.

The Liverpool wheat market was replenished to the extent of 4,000 tons, on Saturday, by the arrival of three California vessels, being, with one exception, the pioneers of the fleet for the current year.

American bark "Lizzie Williams," 125 days passage, with 25,662 cents, valued at \$45,000. She was cleared by Rodgers, Meyer & Co., and has made the quickest trip as yet.

American bark "Atlantic," with 31,687 cents, valued at \$53,000. This vessel was cleared by the same parties as the second wheat ship that left our harbor this season, but was the longest in reaching her destination, being 149 days on the way.

British bark "Dragon," cleared by Mack & Hubback. She was 130 days on the voyage, and carried 20,619 cents, valued at \$34,500.

The prior arrivals in the United Kingdom of shipments hence, since July 1st, consist of the American ship "Carrollton," which reached Liverpool on the 15th of November, in 127 days; and the American ship "Annapolis," anchored on the 1st instant at Queens-town, after a passage of 133 days.

These vessels have arrived at an opportune time, as quotations for California wheat are in the ascendant.

THE telegraph brings the news of Bazaine's conviction, and sentence to death. It seems hard that after forty-two years of honorable service and high command, a brave soldier should suffer such ignominy, but there can scarcely be a doubt that the Marshal, in his devotion to the interests of Napoleon, forgot his allegiance to France, and sacrificed the armies of the young Republic in the vain hope of furthering the designs of his imperial master.

Such being the case, his judges could do nothing less than condemn him to death; but his years of faithful service will plead strongly for pardon, and President MacMahon will, no doubt, be glad to grant it.

THE Daily Arizona Miner, a handsome sheet, full of news and life, and the best sheet printed in that huge territory, came to hand yesterday. Its publishers are John H. Marion & Co., Messrs. Marion and Weaver having associated with them in its publication, E. S. Penwell and C. F. Mitchell. This makes a strong team, and if they are not able to boost the Miner to the very topmost pinnacle of success, why it isn't a bit of use for anybody else to try.

THE propeller Empire, a Washington built ship, has arrived at San Francisco. She is built of Oregon pine, measures 720 tons, and will cost complete about \$45,000. The vessel built by the Reed Bros., and affords ample proof that ship-building on the Pacific Coast can be profitably pursued.

Resources of Los Angeles County.

We clip the following from the Assessor's report on the resources of Los Angeles County. In 1871, the land enclosed in this county was 45,300 acres, and in 1872, 46,000. The acreage cultivated in 1871 was 11,800; in 1872, 12,000. The Assessor seems to have neglected these two items in 1873, at least they do not appear in the report of the Surveyor-General. 
