## Pacific Coast Items.

The wheat shipments from Dixon last week reached 670 tons. An Irish jaunting car, consigned to M. M. Sheehan, of San Jose, passed through Sacramento from the East on Saturday.

A little girl named Nellie Lovejoy was drowned in the Sacramento river on Saturday, having fallen in from the bank on the Yolo side.

J. R. Watson, purchasing agent for the Central Pacific Railroad Company has also been appointed to act as such for the Occidental and Oriental Steamship Company.

D. E. Gordon, editor of the Eureka, Humboldt county, Signal, and Dr. Herbert Thompson wasted considerable powder on each other at Eureka on the 18th without doing any good.

Trinity river was lower at Big Flat on the 4th of July than at any time during the past year. Several companies of Chinese have already commenced operations in the river bed, and many more will follow.

Last Saturday, near Julian, San Diego county, in a quarrel over a land claim, one Webb struck John Cambert a Frenchman, over the head with a rifle, fracturing his skull to such an extent that it is thought his recovery is impossible. Webb is in custody.

About five acres of fine wheat was burned on Brannon Island, on the ranch of Hart Smith, and had it not been for the promptness of the neighbors, who turned out in force, some 300 acres would have been consumed. The fire occurred on the Fourth, and was caused by firecrackers.

Ubeliehe is the euphonious name of a new mineral district located about 20 miles east from Cerro Gordo, by W. L. and J. B. Hunter, Thos. McDonough and J. I. Porter. One of its principal and quite remarkable features is an enormous copper ledge 80 feet in width which assays from 15 to 67 per cent—the whole averaging 24 per cent.

The Inyo Independent of Saturday says: Judging from a view of the crops taken while passing several ranches, we think that the prospects are, on the whole, very promising. Barley is ripening rapidly and wheat in favored spots will be ready for harvest in a few days. Thrashing machines men are preparing for operation and will be in the field next week. Corn has this year been rather backward and should this section be visited with early Autumn frosts, there will be a light crop.

## MISCELLANEOUS.

### RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, It appears to be for the best interest of the Democratic party in this county that the holding of the primary election heretofore ordered should be postponed and that the Democratic electors of this county should express to this Committee their preference as to the manner of nominating candidates for the several offices in said order; now therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Democratic County Central Committee in and for Los Angeles county, as follows: 1st. That the action of this Committee at the meeting thereof held on the 31st day of June, 1875, so far as the same relates to the holding of a primary election in this county at the residence of the electors on the 4th day of July, 1875, be, and the same is, hereby rescinded and annulled, and that the holding of said election be, and the same is, hereby indefinitely postponed.

2d. That a meeting of this Committee be held on the 25th day of July, 1875, at 10 o'clock A. M. of that day, at the office of the Secretary, room 56 Temple Block, in the city of Los Angeles, for the purpose of determining what action shall be taken for the nomination of candidates for the several offices, and that the Democratic electors of this county be, and they are, hereby requested to signify by petition in writing to this Committee their preference as to the best mode to be adopted for the nomination of candidates for said offices.

3d. That the Secretary of this Committee be, and he is, hereby instructed to certify to the several offices in said order, and for the Democratic County Central Committee in and for Los Angeles county, at a meeting thereof held on the 14th day of July, A. D. 1875.
