

The Perils of Surf Bathing.

The New York papers of Monday contain the most particular details of the drowning of four persons while bathing which was briefly reported yesterday. A letter from the Herald on Saturday morning about ten o'clock, from John Whittaker, of Trenton, N. J., and Dr. Dummer, of Jersey city, went to the Metropolitan Hotel, in company with two ladies. It appeared in the place where they entered is considered safe, on account of what fishermen call a "sea pass," i. e. a rush of water between two sand hills. It seems the ladies and Mr. Whittaker lost their footing in the water and were swept into deep water. Mr. J. who was an excellent swimmer, succeeded in getting the ladies into a place of safety, but, unfortunately, lost his strength and went down. The greatest confusion prevailed along the beach, and several minutes elapsed before a boat was launched and one of the ladies taken out.

In the meantime, a young Canadian gentleman, Mr. Ardagh, stopping at the Allegany House, who was bathing about two hundred yards to the south of where the accident occurred, ran up and plunged in. With much difficulty he succeeded in reaching him, and, endeavoring to drag him to the shore, his strength, however, was rapidly failing, and he was obliged to let go close that the bystanders dragged both out. Mr. Ardagh's courage is beyond praise. While the ladies stood on the beach watching the unfortunate man struggling helplessly, he also ventured into the boiling surf, and, in the imminent risk of his life, he made a most successful effort to save the young man. After he was rescued, Mr. Ardagh lay all night on the beach, but we are assured that he has now entirely recovered from the effects of his heroic conduct. It was found impossible, however, to resuscitate the bodies of the unfortunate men. A letter from Long Branch immediately subscribed \$100 to present a testimonial to Mr. Ardagh for his bravery.

The wife and a son of Mr. Whittaker were with him at the place, where he had been a customer for many years. He is said to have been an expert swimmer. Mr. Whittaker was engaged in the glass manufactory, and was very highly respected. His age was about 60 years. Mr. Dummer was unmarried, about 35 years of age, and lived at Jersey City with his mother and sister—the bodies of both the unfortunate men were recovered.

A similar casualty occurred at Nevasink bridge on Sunday. It appears that Gustavus A. Ratz, the well-known secretary of the Liquor Dealers' association, his wife and Miss Frances Evans, R. D. Evans and Mrs. John Van Tine, were in bathing at the Nevasink Highlands, when the force of the current carried them beyond their depth. A letter to the Herald says: "Sensible of their danger they called for assistance. It was an exciting time. The men strove to save the ladies. Several of the men on the beach ran for a boat. Excepting Mr. Ratz and one of the party were specifically named, the party were in the water, being carried further from the shore. Knowing that Mr. Ratz was a powerful and expert swimmer, but little apprehension was felt for his safety. He was seen to sink, being his head from his eyes, and he had been vainly endeavoring to bring to the shore. Quickly Mr. Evans, although nearly exhausted from his previous efforts to save the lives of those who had been rescued, plunged into the water and swam for Mrs. Ratz. He took hold of her with one of his hands, and, reaching and grasping her, he was assisted by others, she was pulled to the beach. Meantime Mr. Ratz was seen to rise to the surface again. In ten minutes his body was washed ashore. Now came the most exciting time of all—the efforts to resuscitate Mr. Ratz and his wife. Several physicians who were present resorted to the usual means employed for resuscitating drowned persons. In the case of Mr. Ratz the efforts proved successful. It was beyond the skill of the medical attendants to resuscitate Mr. Ratz.

Merely that the physicians given up their labors, and endeavored to bring back to the body of Mr. Ratz the spark of life, when they were called on to return, if possible, life to the unfortunate form of a young man named Theodore, from Buffalo, just taken from the water close by. Gardner and several youths about the same age were in swimming, a life further up the beach, when the former was carried by the same undertow beyond his depth. Every available means were used to resuscitate him, but they were of no avail. Intense excitement followed the news of the drowning. People rushed from the hotels, and many of the victims of the catastrophe. Mr. R. was only twenty-seven years of age. He was formerly a clerk in the office of August Belmont, and was at the time of his death a member of the seventh regiment.

We also hear of sales at points above at 50 cents, November delivery, with 2,000 head at Cincinnati, same delivery at 40. From all the information we can gather, the increase in the hog crop will be large in Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota and North Illinois."

NEW YORK, Aug. 14.—The weekly statement of the New York City banks shows a decrease of \$263,000 in loans; \$552,000 in specie; \$16,000 in circulation, and \$908,000 in deposits.

The decline of beef cattle at New York last week resulted in the loss of about \$30,000 to the cattle brokers and speculators.
