

LOCAL NEWS.

City Council.—The last regular meeting of the present City Council was held last night. As the rooms lately used by the two Boards for their place of meeting were destroyed by the fire at Liberty Hall, last Saturday night, the meeting was held in Harmonie Hall, where the meetings of the City Council were held immediately after the destruction of the chambers of the two Boards in the old Market House. But few spectators were present. For official proceedings see another column.

Mr. Hopkins asked if there were not laws with reference to this question. The President said he thought there were, but that the only copy of the Corporation laws he ever had was burnt at the late fire. The resolution then, on motion of Mr. Hughes, was referred to the Committee on Streets.

For sometime past they have occupied the large warehouse on the southwest corner of King and Water streets, formerly known as the Corn Exchange, as their factory, and there they employ about twenty-five hands in the various processes connected with the making and packing of cigars.
