Gov. Wade Hampton, of South Carolina, in his speech at the Winnebago county (Ill.) Agricultural Fair, last week, said:

"We have had too much of war—we, at least, of the South have—and we need now, above all things, peace, and it is to plead for peace that I am here to-day. I make no concealment of the part taken by myself in the late war, nor would your respect for us be increased were I to offer any unmanly apology. Up to the beginning of the contest I used all my influence to preserve the Union, to avoid the war; but when that came I obeyed the command of my State, as you did yours, and I found you as long and as hard as I could. But when I surrendered I did so in good faith, and from that day to this I challenge any one to show that the terms of my parole have been violated or that any act of mine has been consistent with my honor as a soldier and my duty as a citizen.
