### Love as an Investment.

[Applause.] It is the only thing that will pay you. Joy is wealth. Love is the legal tender of the soul—[laughter]—and you need not be rich to be happy. We have all been raised on success in this country.—Always been talked with about being successful and have never thought ourselves very rich unless we are the possessors of some magnificent mansion and unless our names have been blown in the nostrils of rumor we could not be happy. Every little baby striving to be this and that. I tell you the happy man is the successful man. The man who has won the love of one good woman is a successful man. The man that has been the emperor of one good heart, and that heart embraces all his has been a success. [Applause.] It another has been the emperor of the round world and has never loved and been loved his life is a failure.  
It won't do. But as to my children the other way, that the happy man is the successful man, and he who is a happy man is the one who always tries to make some one else happy. [Applause.] The man who married a woman to make her happy; that man married her as much for her own sake as for his own; or the man that thinks his wife is his property, who thinks that the title to her belongs to him—that the woman is the property of the man; wretches who get into at their wives and then shoot them down in the street because they think the woman is their property [loud applause]. I tell you it is not necessary to be rich and great and powerful to be happy. A little while ago I stood by the grave of the old Napoleon—a magnificent tomb of marble and gold; it almost for a dial day—and I gazed upon the sarcophagus of black Egyptian marble, which, at last the ashes of the ruler-king, I leaned over the balustrade and thought about the career of the greatest soldier of the modern world. I saw him working on the banks of the Seine, contemplating suicide. I saw him at Toulon—I saw him putting down the mob in the streets of Paris—I saw him at the head of the army of Italy—I saw him crossing the bridge of Lodi with the tri color in his hand—I saw him in Egypt in the shadow of the pyramids—I saw him conquer the Alps and mingle the eagles of France with the eagles of the eagle. I saw him at Marengo at Ulm and Austerlitz. I saw him in Russia—the infancy of the snow and the cavalry of the wild blast scattered his legions like winter's withered leaves. I saw him at Leipzig in defeat and disaster driven by a million of bayoneted men upon Paris, clutched like a wild beast, banished to Elba. I saw him upon the frigate, and I saw him at last the ashes of the ruler-king. And I saw him at St. Helena, with his hands crossed behind him, gazing out upon the sad and solemn sea.  
I thought of the orphans and widows he had made of the tears that had been shed for his glory, and of the only woman who ever loved him, pushed from his heart by the cold hand of ambition.
