Graham vs. The Washington City, Virginia Midland and Great Southern R.R. Company and others on the 13th day of February, 1881, a public sale, in front of the Market Building, on Prince Street, in the city of Alexandria, in the County of Virginia, at twelve (12) o'clock, on THURSDAY, the 13th day of May, 1881, sell at public auction to the highest bidder the following described property:

The entire line of railroad known as the Washington City, Virginia Midland and Great Southern Rail Road, lying between the city of Alexandria and the city of Danville, and from the town of Manassas, in the county of Prince William, on the western main line, to the town of Harrisonburg, in the county of Rockingham, together with all the branches thereof as they now exist, with all appurtenances and equipment, rights, privileges, franchises, properties, real and personal, and works to the said railroad and branches respectively belonging, or in anywise appertaining, including the roadway and tracks, rails and roadbed, side tracks, bridges, viaducts, trestles, fences, stations, depots, machine shops, and all other buildings and structures, docks and wharves, said and gravel pits, and deposits of materials and all other things, real and personal, and all other things, real and personal, in connection with the said railroad or branches thereof, respectively, together with all locomotives and tenders, freight and passenger cars, and all other cars, and all other rolling stock, and all other equipment, machinery, tools, and materials for the use of said railroad, or any of its branches and all other personal property thereunto belonging, including all property and things whatsoever of any such nature or description as is above mentioned.
