STATE DEMOCRATIC TICKET

FOR GOVERNOR JOHN W. DANIEL, OF LYNCHBURG. FOR LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR JAMES BARBOUR, OF CULPEPER. FOR ATTORNEY GENERAL P. W. MCKINNEY, OF FARMWELL.

The State Democratic Convention late last night nominated for Governor Major John W. Daniel, of Lynchburg, and a more worthy standard bearer could not have been selected, combining in such an eminent degree all the qualifications that fit him for the exalted position to which he will rise; certainly he chosen in November next.

For the position of Lieutenant Governor the convention wisely selected Mr. James Barbour, of Culpeper, a gentleman of undoubted ability, of large experience and a true and tried democrat, whose fealty to his party and the best interests of his State were always paramount to his views upon any special question, and who will give additional strength to the ticket.

And then, to finish the ticket, and make all its parts equally strong and attractive, P. W. McKinney, esq., of Farmville, was nominated for Attorney General.

The convention certainly did its work well, and has given to the people of the State a ticket which they may well take pride in electing, knowing that with the relics of government in such hands all will go well with the Old Commonwealth.

That Major Daniel is a friend of the public schools is known to everybody at all acquainted with him. If he ever said he would rather the public schools were razed than that the State should repudiate her debt, which is not certain, he did so upon sufficient ground and with as good reason as other noble men have preferred death to dishonor, and no dishonor could be more injurious to Virginia than the repudiation of any portion of her just debt.

The State Democratic Convention. RICHMOND, August 5.—The convention re-assembled at 8 o'clock last night, and was addressed in an able and eloquent speech by Hon. John T. Harris, presaging the success of the party by an overwhelming majority.

The conservative democratic party of Virginia—democratic in its federal relations and conservative in its State policy—sembled in convention, in view of the present condition of the Union and of this Commonwealth, for the clear and distinct assertion of its political principles and to declare that we adopt the following articles of political faith:

1. Equality of right and exact justice to all men, special privileges to none; freedom of religion, freedom of the press, and freedom of the person under the protection of the habeas corpus; of trial by jury impartially selected, and of a pure, upright, and non-partisan judiciary; elections by the people, free from force or fraud of citizens, or of the military and civil officers of government; and the selection for public offices of those who are honest and best fitted to fill them; the support of the State government in all its rights as the most competent administrators of our domestic affairs and the surest bulwarks against anti-republican tendencies; and the preservation of the general government in its whole constitutional vigor, as the sheet anchor of our peace at home and our safety abroad.

2. That the maintenance of the public credit of Virginia is an essential means to the promotion of her prosperity. We condemn repudiation in every shape and form as a blot upon her honor, a blow at her permanent welfare, and an obstacle to her progress in wealth, influence, and power; and that we will make every effort to secure a settlement of the public debt, with the consent of her creditors, which is consistent with her honor and dictated by justice and sound public policy; that it is eminently desirable and proper that the several classes of the debt now existing should be paid, so that equality, which is equity, may control in the annual payment of interest, and the ultimate redemption of principal; that with a view of securing such equality we pledge our party to use all lawful authority to secure a settlement of the State debt so that there shall be but one class of the public debt; that we will use all lawful and constitutional means in our power to secure a settlement of the State debt upon the basis of a 3 per cent bond, and that the conservative democratic party pledges itself, as a part of its policy, not to increase the present rate of taxation.

3. That we will uphold, in its full constitutional integrity and efficiency, our public school system for the education of both white and colored children, as established by the Constitution of the State and established by the action of the conservative party years before it was required by the Constitution; and will take the most effectual means for the faithful execution of the same by applying to its support all the revenues set apart for that object by the Constitution or otherwise.

4. Upon this declaration of principles we solemnly invite the consideration of all conservative democrats, whatever may have been or now are their views upon the public debt, in the election of the nominees of this Convention and in the maintenance of the supremacy of the democratic party in the State.

Resolved further, That any intimation, coming from any quarter, that the conservative democratic party of Virginia has been, is now, or proposes to be opposed to an honest ballot and a fair count is a calumny upon the State of Virginia as unfounded in fact as it is dishonorable to its authors.

He ate about the usual quantity of breakfast, his fare consisting of beefsteak, potatoes, toast, and milk, and has up to this hour rested quietly and comfortably. His pulse is not high; he is entirely free from fever, and is at this moment going to sleep.

A Descent on a Pennsylvania Village. PITTSBURGH, Pa., Aug. 5.—The section of country around McKeesport was in a condition of terrible confusion and excitement last night. Word has just reached this city that the burglars and the men supposed to have been concerned in the murder of McClure made a descent on the village of Birds and killed a number of the citizens. They had been hiding in the coal mines about there, and were probably starved out, as when they made their appearance in Ellrods they asked for food. This was refused them by the citizens, who suspected who they were. The desperadoes immediately began firing on the citizens, and it is feared, with fatal results, as a number are reported killed. The Chief of Police has been telegraphed for and asked to bring assistance. A band of fifty mounted men has left McKeesport in pursuit of the murderers and there is a strong determination to lynch them if caught.

The Weather. CHICAGO, Aug. 5.—The indications this morning are that the heat of to-day will exceed that of yesterday, which was the hottest day of the season so far. A cold wave is, however, on its way from Manitoba. The thermometer has registered to-day in different parts of the State from 103 to 106.

Severe Storm. PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 5.—A severe storm swept over this section of the State last evening, and extended as far as Milwaukee, in Wisconsin. The greatest damage was done in Minneapolis. For a time it raged as if it were a cyclone. Much damage was done.

Hartmann a Fugitive. NEW YORK, Aug. 5.—Leo Hartmann, the thief, has left the United States and sought refuge in Canada, because of the possibility of his being delivered up by the government of the United States to the Russian authorities. Mr. Hartmann left this city on Tuesday night, and it is understood that he crossed the frontier of Canada yesterday.

Burning of an Elevator. CLEVELAND, O., July 5.—A special to the Leader from Fremont, says: "The friction of the machinery set fire to the Lake Erie and Western Co.'s elevator, one mile from here last evening, and it was entirely destroyed. The elevator was valued at \$18,000."

The North Carolina Elections. RALPHAM, N. C., Aug. 6.—Reports from 17 counties give a majority of 1,000 for the conservative party. The other counties will probably run up to 60,000 for the Whites divided; the negroes did not, but voted solidly against the proposed measure.

Burning of a Steamer. FREDERICKTON, N. B., Aug. 5.—The steamer Royal was burned to the water's edge early this morning. She arrived from St. John at 7 o'clock last night. The fire spread with great rapidity. The crew barely escaped with their lives and in a nude state.

Death of a Linguist. LONDON, Aug. 5.—The death is announced of Theodore Bergs, German linguist and professor of Greek and Latin in the University of Berlin, who died at his residence in Berlin, aged 70 years.

Financial. NEW YORK, Aug. 5.—The Post's financial article says: "The stock exchange could not well be duller than today at the opening of business. The general speculative list is lower than yesterday. Truck line shares and coal shares being heavy. United States bonds are a favor for the 4s and there are no other changes. State bonds declined 1/2 for Louisiana 4s and recovered 1/4. Railroad bonds are irregular, but generally lower, the change being fractional. The money market is easy at 2 1/2 per cent. for call loans, 3 1/2 per cent. for time loans and 3 1/4 for prime mercantile paper."
