Laws. The following bills having passed the Legislature and been approved by the Governor have become laws:

To amend the Code in relation to vacating the offices of judges for failure to qualify; to authorize the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, at Strasburg, to borrow money; vacating the offices of the Visitors of the Deaf and Blind Institute at Staunton; to incorporate the order of the Brothers and Sisters of Love and Charity, of Clarke co; to authorize the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun county to allow compensation to Judge J. L. Cochran for holding terms of County Court of Loudoun in place of Judge Lane, who was then sick; to amend the Code in relation to mandamus, prohibition, &c.; to prevent attorneys at law who fail to pay over moneys and liabilities received by them from practicing in the courts of the Commonwealth; and to incorporate the Virginia Gold Belt Company.

A WOMAN'S VENGEANCE.—Charles McCue came to Pittsburg, Pa., about three years ago from some place in the East. He became acquainted with a young and rather pretty dressmaker, named Lizzie McCue. She was not, however, related to him. She left suddenly last August, and it is supposed that she had a sad cause for her departure and that McCue was connected with it. About four weeks ago she came back, and since then has several times sent word to McCue that she wished to see him, but he did not comply with her request. About half-past one o'clock on Sunday Miss McCue went to the lumber yard where Charles was at work and asked him what he was going to do in regard to her. Not receiving a satisfactory reply she drew a cocked revolver from her shawl and shot him in the right breast. He ran off and she shot at him again, but missed him. She was subsequently locked up. The doctors say that the wounded man will probably die, as they think the ball is in his lung.
