COMMUNICATED.

Mount Vernon Avenue.

Many a scheme projected for public convenience and general improvement although in the main practicable and commending itself to popular favor utterly fails of success because of the fatally extravagant ideas of its projectors. May it not be so with the scheme in which we are all so much interested just now, of laying out and constructing a highway from the national capital to the home and shrine of General Washington. An avenue to connect these two historic places should be one of no insignificant dimensions, but one broad enough for commanding display as well as to amply accommodate the diverse and frequent travel which it would at all times insure. But to start out with the proposition that it should be two hundred feet wide is simply absurd, at least so it seems to the writer.

Let us consider the matter. In the first place certain concessions are to be obtained of all property holders through whom the road is to be projected. All lands are to be appraised at a fair valuation and payment therefor made to the owners. For a way of such dimensions as have been proposed for it, twelve acres of land would be required for every mile of construction. Where land is rated at from forty to fifty dollars per acre only, the cost of the right of way will not be so great, but where one or two thousand dollars will be demanded for suburban acres the concessions will grow into large items of expense. In a width of two hundred feet we suppose the design is to park fifty feet on each side. This would leave one hundred feet for actual road or driving way, a space even wider than the drive way of Pennsylvania avenue and sufficiently ample to admit of the movement of a dozen carriages abreast. And such a road, even with the great natural advantages, which are afforded for its construction both by the easy gradients of the grounds and the convenience of many of the needed materials such as boulders and cobble stones for deep bedding, and gravel and sand for cement finish, the cost would not be less than fifty thousand dollars per mile exclusive of the two bridges over Great and Little Hunting Creeks. These structures if in keeping with all the other magnificent designs, and if built of iron on enduring foundations, would add to each mile an additional cost of ten thousand dollars. So that the avenue when finished and ready for travel would represent an expenditure of nearly one million of dollars or more, but not inclusive of parking and other adornments. Now, unless the general and State governments could be induced to make very the magnificent undertaking the work would probably be a forbidding one to any incorporated company. But narrow the proposed dimensions down to one half—make the actual roadway fifty feet in width, with twenty-five feet on each side for parking, stables and other accessories for ornamentation, which would proportionately diminish the cost, then, we think, people generally would be disposed to look upon it as entirely practicable and that the necessary energies and means could be readily found to make the scheme a success. The foregoing remarks have not been prompted by any capricious spirit but only through a wish that in all the preliminary movements which are now being made by our people the best judgment and the most practical considerations may determine their action. The enterprise is one of great moment and I don't wish to see its success impeded by any false or unwarranted step in its inception. And while I would deprecate all extravagant ideas of construction, I would not feel satisfied to have the sentiment of our people acquiescing in a cheap road, or any other than one which would be a credit to the magnanimity of a great and prosperous nation, and a fitting memorial to the great chief whom we all love to honor and revere.
