HORRIBLE AFFAIR.—Another case of premature burial worthy of being analyzed in the realistic manner of Zola has occurred in France. An elderly woman who lived at an Old World place called St. Ouen La Ronerie recently fell ill and, as her friends thought, died. The funeral took place, and as the gravedigger was preparing to lower the coffin into the earth he heard moans issuing from inside the lugubrious four boards inclosing the presumed corpse. Then followed a scene which was an exact counterpart of what occurred about twelve months ago in another rural part of France.
