A FOOLHARDY ACHIEVEMENT is reported in the Toronto Mail. It states that a French Canadian, a few days ago, performed the extraordinary feat of walking along the brink of the Chaudiere Falls, from the Hull to the Ottawa side of the river. A wager of \$10 with a friend was the inducement to run the risk. The feat was only rendered possible by the phenomenal looseness of the water in the river, and the addition of a new dam to the former series of dams across the river above the falls. The man, after putting on a pair of ratman's boots well corked, with the usual sharp nails in the sole, started to walk across. He proceeded about ten feet from the brink, and walked steadily until about three quarters of the way across, when the current became very strong and the water deeper. A single slip might have plunged him into the seething cauldron beneath. Steadying himself, he proceeded cautiously, carefully planting one foot on the rocks before lifting the other, and, in a few minutes from the time he started, he climbed up on a pier below the saw mill.
