A NEW MODE OF HARBOR DEFENSE.

Rear Admiral Luce, of the navy, recently visited Philadelphia harbor in a steam launch by the canal route, because he wanted to examine the practicability of a big scheme and the best way to do it was from the deck of the launch. A company backed by millions of dollars has proposed to the Secretary of the Navy a striking and possibly effective scheme for the defense of that harbor and the harbors of other cities from the attacks of an enemy's fleet by shooting ignited petroleum at the unfriendly ships from the bottom of the river and burning them up.

SOME STARCH FOODS.

Cooking starch is got from maize, and, besides corn and potatoes, there are several other sources of starch foods. Arrowroot is got from a West Indian plant, by grinding and rasping the root and washing the pulp, which is 25 per cent. starch, the grains of this separating from the rest.


