KEEPING PEOPLE OUT OF THEIR MONEY.—Congressman Tom Read, of Maine, was sitting in the ways and means committee room the other day examining quite a huge document, when all of a sudden he bit the end of a cigar, touched a match to it, and said in his peculiarly emphatic way: "The United States government is the worst party to have any dealings with I know of. There's a communication from a lighthouse keeper on the coast of Maine. The Treasury department has refused to allow him \$13, and he wants me to get it for him. It has been my experience for ten years or more that the United States government doesn't try to allow any claims, but the game is always to keep people out of all the money possible. This thing of the government not paying its creditors interest is absurd. Why shouldn't the government pay interest as well as any other debtor? I suppose they got that idea from the old custom in foreign countries of not charging the king interest under the belief that the king could do no wrong." The big, blunt Congressman went on to make other pointed and uncompromising remarks about the government until he got considerably excited.—Cor. St. Louis Republic.
