

The Anti-Mahoneites' Proposition.

As stated in the GAZETTE a delegation composed of about 150 of the most prominent members of the anti-Mahone party met at the Ebbitt House, Washington, yesterday, and prepared a communication, addressed to General Mahone, to be submitted to his committee for their approval or rejection. The communication is as follows:

WASHINGTON, May 29, 1889.

To Gen. Wm. Mahone, Chairman, &c.

General—I am instructed by the organization which I represent to ask you to submit to the committee over which you preside the subjoined suggestions. They are proffered with a sincere desire to ascertain some fair basis on which the republicans of Virginia can be united against a common foe, and we are willing to sacrifice everything but principle to the attainment of this end.

It is proposed that the committee over which you preside shall appoint two representatives to meet two gentlemen similarly selected by that branch of the Virginia party which I represent, and that the four persons so chosen shall be authorized upon disagreement to select a fifth republican to have a voice and vote in their deliberations. Next, that the committee, so jointly formed, shall be empowered to arrange and give notice of republican meetings throughout Virginia, on a date to be agreed upon, and all on the same date, at which the republican voters shall be called on to organize their own meetings, elect the chairman and secretary thereof, and to choose the delegates to a State convention, the time, place and representation of such convention having been previously notified to the public by reasonable notice from the joint committee. The meeting for the election of delegates to the State, as well as at the same time; that is, either all shall be mass meetings or all precinct or ward meetings, whether in cities, towns or counties. It shall be further agreed and stipulated that the chairman and secretary elected by such meeting shall certify the delegates elected, and that such certificate shall constitute the credentials of delegates to the temporary organization of the State convention, and that the roll shall be made up on such certificates by the joint committee, who shall also have charge of the building in which the State convention is held and admission thereto. And further, that when a State convention so chosen shall have assembled, and shall have been called to order by a person elected by a said joint standing committee, then the convention itself shall elect its own temporary chairman. These are the leading and essential features of the overture which I am authorized to submit to your committee. Details beneath the foregoing essentials to be left to the decision of our joint representatives. It remains for me to say that this plan of compromise having been acceded to and carried into effect, those for whom I speak will manfully abide the result, and will battle earnestly for the nominees of the convention, and the same pledge is expected from those whom your committee represent.

Respectfully yours, V. D. GRONER, chairman.

The President, in a letter addressed to General Groner, acknowledges the receipt of a copy of the above communication, and said that on his return from Brooklyn he would communicate with him fixing the day on which the committee would be received.
