Deliberate Killing. Major C. E. McGregor shot and killed Col. J. M. W. Cody on the streets of Warrenton, Ga., on Saturday. McGregor shot Cody first through the heart and then twice through the brain. He immediately surrendered himself to the authorities. Major McGregor is agent of the Georgia Railroad at Warrenton. The difficulty which ended in the death of Mr. Cody began over a year ago, the true inwardness of which was never made public, as there was a woman in the case. McGregor and Cody had a difficulty about this woman, after which McGregor claims Cody attempted to assault him one night. Mr. Cody was indicted for assault, with intent to murder, but gave bond, and had been seen in Warrenton every day until the case was called, when he could not be found. Diligent search had been made for him all over the county by the officers of the law, but he could not be found until he appeared upon the streets of Warrenton Saturday morning, when the difficulty between himself and Mr. McGregor was renewed. McGregor was standing in front of Captain Thomas's store on the opposite side of the street when Cody drove by. He watched Cody get out, and in a minute or two after Cody alighted McGregor was kneeling across the street with his hand in his pocket and marched squarely up to Cody. Drawing a pistol he presented it to Cody's breast and fired, the ball penetrating the right breast. Major McGregor was seen after the killing and said: "When Cody deliberately evaded the law and flaunted his impudent defiance in my face it was more than human nature could stand. If the courts would not punish this man for trying to assassinate me I determined to do it myself. I tried to put my bullet just where he put his in me on December 23, 1887, and I don't think I missed it one inch. Yesterday McGregor was transferred from the Warrenton jail and taken to Augusta, where he will remain for safe keeping."

SALE OF PROPERTY FOR NON-PAYMENT OF CITY TAXES. Under the following resolution passed by the City Council, Tuesday, August 8, 1889, we will expose at public auction on Wednesday, October 23rd, 1889, in front of the Market Building, Royal street, Alexandria, Va., the following LOTS AND IMPROVEMENTS thereon, so much thereof as may be necessary to pay and satisfy the taxes, assessments or charges due to the City Council of Alexandria on the same. Resolved, That the Collectors of Taxes, under the supervision of the City Auditor be and they are hereby directed to proceed and sell at public auction all real estate in the city of Alexandria, on which taxes are due and unpaid to June 1, 1889, in conformity to the City Charter. Said sale to commence on Wednesday the 23rd day of October, 1889. The purchasers will be required to pay at the time of sale the taxes, assessments, charges and expenses of sale.
