THE ELECTION held in this city yesterday was one of the most quiet and orderly that ever took place. The election was for Commonwealth's Attorney, City Sergeant, Commissioner of Revenue, Magistrates and Constables, and for a member of the Board of Aldermen for the First Ward to fill a vacancy. The nominees of the recent democratic primary had no opposition and yesterday's election was merely a formal affair. The vote was a comparatively small affair and but few negroes cast ballots or were even seen about the polls. MONETARY AND COMMERCIAL.

The feature of the money market this week has been the transactions in Virginia bonds, about \$50,000 of the various issues of which were sold in this city at the advance caused by Monday's decision of the Supreme Court in the Virginia coupon cases. The general business of the city has been fairly active, though the recent decline in grain has been felt. The rate for money here continues unchanged. In New York it is quoted at 3 7/8. NEW YORK, May 23.—The stock market displayed less animation this morning than on any day for weeks. The reactionary temper was again shown, and although first prices were generally small fractions better than last evening's figures, the improvement could not be maintained and most stocks traded in retired slightly below the opening. A somewhat better tone prevailed late in the hour and slightly better figures were attained. At 11 o'clock the market was only fairly active and firm, generally at a shade under first prices.
