Mayor's Office, Alexandria, Va., May 31, 1890. All persons owning or intending to keep any animal of the dog or canine species must come forward ON OR BEFORE JUNE ELEVENTH, 1890, and take out a license for the same from the Auditor. After the 11th of June all persons owning or harboring dogs found on his, her or their premises without the required license will be fined (as the laws on the subject require) \$5 for every dog so owned or harbored.
