**Cranky Rube the Negro Messiah.**  
A dispatch from Kansas City, Mo., says that what was at first a source of amusement to Chief of Police Speers has become a matter of serious consideration. Early last week a number of colored men called upon the chief to ask permission to hold ghost dances, saying that they had a new Messiah who would lead them to a promised land. The chief granted their request and considered the whole matter a huge joke. The craze has, however, assumed the proportions of something more than a joke and is now rapidly spreading among the more ignorant classes of colored people throughout the city.

Some ten or fifteen days ago a tall, gaunt man, as black as coal, made his appearance in what is known as "Hell's Half Acre," in the packing house district, and announced himself as the Messiah sent to save the colored race. This man was Rube Carter, who had long been known as "Cranky Rube." He went among the negroes and gradually drew converts to his ideas, and at last accumulated quite a following among the negroes in the west bottom.

Carter has been talking about the destruction of the whole white race and says the calamity is to occur next spring, and warns the blacks to follow him if they would escape the general destruction. He tells them that all who remain with the white will suffer their fate, but those who go with him to the promised land will be placed in power and the wealth of the world will be theirs. His story is a sort of revised edition of the Indian craze, and he has evidently been reading of what is going on among the reds.

He claims that the promised land is in Oklahoma and says he will lead all the believers there in the spring, and they will then see that he possesses miraculous power. He promises that cities will rise in a night for the occupancy of the people who follow him, and these cities will be made by the angels of God, who will be sent to serve him. He enters into a tedious description of the cities and it tallies exactly with the description of the city described in the Revelation of the Bible. He says the city will be called the New Jerusalem and will be built of gold and precious stones.

The permission granted by the Chief of Police for holding ghost dances has been fully taken advantage of, and the colored people in the districts mentioned have been holding nightly revivals which they call religious dances, but which are now beginning to assume the appearance of idolatrous orgies. As the dancing continues the negroes appear to go back to their ancient savagery, and their movements now resemble the incantation of the voodoo dances of the South. Men and women join in the craze, and they are becoming wilder and wilder every night, until now the chief of Police is seriously thinking of revoking his permission and stopping the dancing.

Carter has disappeared, and the followers say that he is in retirement until New Year's Day, when he will appear in all his glory and show his wonderful power by signs and miracles. The dancing, which heretofore has been public to anyone who desired to witness it, is now done in secret and admission is refused to all who do not believe in the power of the Messiah. There is no doubt that the man has gained great control over the ignorant people of his race, and unless some measures are taken to stop the craze there will be trouble with the converts.

**SITTING BULL'S GHOST.**—A dispatch from the Standing Rock Agency, S. D., says: A ranch man named Tom Hetlund, located 35 miles up Bad River, arrived on Saturday. He says a peaceable, Christianized and semi-civilized tribe of Two Kettle Sioux are now seized with sudden frenzy and are imitating the wildest orgies of the ghost dance indulged in by the hostiles. His account is as follows:  
"Night before last some Indians were returning from a little social gathering when a sight met their eyes which chilled them to the bone. One of their number directed attention to the top of a bluff, and there stood a figure in white, perfectly motionless. Suddenly one of them cried out in Sioux, 'It's Sitting Bull!' Then did the marrow in the bones of these Indians grow cold and their teeth chattered like beads in a barrel. The phantom suddenly commenced waving an arm as if motioning them to follow, and with the speed of a bird glided from hilltop to hilltop, finally disappearing in the direction of the Bad Lands. Only one interpretation could be given this ghastly visitation. Sitting Bull is true identified as really the Simon pure, long denoted for Messiah, and he was beckoning them on to join his followers and avenge his spirit. A ghost dance is the consequence and the spirit has moved down the river, and according to Hetlund it has effected them as far down as Willow creek."
