HUMAN AURAS PICTURED. Mrs. Annie Besant, of London, who declares that the soul of the high priestess of theosophy, the late Mme. Blavatsky, now dwells in the physical body of a Brahmin youth, delivered her first lecture in this country Sunday night at Chickering Hall New York. She had a large audience.

She told about the many seats or bodies which theosophy asserts that man possesses, and said that the physical body was the lowest and least developed of all.

Mrs. Besant's lecture especially dealt with the auras, which theosophy teaches surround all things animate and inanimate. By means of a magic lantern the auras of fully civilized man and undeveloped man were shown.
