DOCTOR RISKED HIS LIFE.
In performing a charitable act Dr. Dowling Benjamin, of Camden, endangered his life and the aid of several fellow physicians has been called in to save him. Dr. Benjamin is one of the best known surgeons in the State and is one of the officers of the New Jersey Society Sons of the American Revolution. One day last week he was called to attend the infant child of a very poor family for which he had done some charitable work. The little one was suffering from membranous croup and when Dr. Benjamin reached the house was slowly choking to death. The doctor made all haste to insert a tube through the membrane of the throat in order to give the little sufferer breath while he administered anti-toxine. While applying the tube, a necessarily painful operation, the poor child closed upon his hand and broke the skin of one of his fingers with its teeth. The operation was successful and the child is rapidly recovering. As soon as he reached his home on Cooper street, Dr. Benjamin applied an antiseptic to the wound on his finger and thought no more of it. By the next morning, however, his finger and then his hand had swollen enormously, while the inflammation and pain were intense. The doctor recognized blood poisoning and cared for himself as best he could, but by Saturday last the poison had extended up his arm to his shoulder and he was in such a serious condition that he was compelled to go to bed and send for professional aid. He called in two of the city's leading practitioners, Dr. E. L. B. Goffrey and W. A. Davis, who have since watched him closely. Dr. Benjamin was somewhat better yesterday, the swelling and inflammation being considerably subsided, but he is still in a threatening condition.

AN OLD MILL.—Seventy-five yards in Prince William county and about fifty yards from the Thoroughfare flour mills, better known as Beverley's mills, stand the ends of the old stone building which was once known as Thoroughfare depot and is no doubt the oldest landmark in that section. Up at the very top of the eastern gable inscribed in a stone are the following words: "Built in 1803 by B. and S. Dean." At the time it was built it was on the county road and at that time was only used as a store. When the "Manassas Gap railroad," as it was then called, was built in the county road, the railroad company established an agency there. Verbal history as far as I am able to learn has nothing to say in regard to its former name or whether it had any name or not. However, when the railroad was built it was called Thoroughfare depot as it was situated in the Thoroughfare gap. Up until the close of the war it was used as a store house and depot, since then no attention has been paid to it. It caught fire from a railroad engine about eight years ago which consumed all the woodwork. The side walls soon afterwards fell in but the ends are standing to-day as monuments to the skill of masonry which was used in their construction. —[Warrenton Virginia.]
