SECOND BATTLE OF FLOWERS AT CANNES.
A dispatch from Cannes says: A fatality seemed to pursue the second battle of flowers. It was postponed from Thursday to Saturday because of the national mourning and eventually only took place Monday, the weather being too unsettled on Saturday. However, everything was in favor of the success of the battle, which turned out to be infinitely prettier and more animated than the last. The tributes were crowned with fashion and beauty, and Cannes has rarely seen such exquisitely decorated carriages.
One magnificent equipage was M. and Mme. de Pomeroy's landau, completely masked with Marechal Niel roses, orchids, hyacinths and great scarlet noisettes, holding bouquets on the sides. It created a veritable sensation. Another superb landau was covered with nothing but pink and white roses and hovering over the flowers was a butterfly made of violets, with transparent gauze wings. Mme. Caproni's victoria was one of the prettiest carriages present.
In a delightful little "charrette anglaise," trimmed with mimosa and streamers of yellow ribbon and drawn by a little donkey were the three lovely children of Mrs. Cotton; one, dressed as a Pierrot, was the diminutive coachman. Mrs. Alluett's landau, trimmed with roses and violets, was also most effective. But how impossible to give an adequate description of all the gay cars and carriages which passed by for the tributes! From half past two until four the merry battle raged furiously; bouquets and bunches of flowers were circling in the air until it seemed a storm of blossoms.
In the "tribunes d'honneur" were the Duke of Cambridge, Lord and Lady Brougham and Vaux, Prince and Princess Radziwill, Comte and Comtesse Chandon de Briales, Admiral Friz George, Mr. and Mrs. Frederic Walker, Marquis and Marquise de Rochechouart, Vicomte and Vicomtesse de Labrosse, and Mlle. de Labrosse, Lou Kilmarnock, Lord Rendel, Comte and Comtesse de Suzanet, Comtesse Herman de Pourtales, Vicomte de Saint Sime, Vicomte de Nautois, the Marquis de Pallavicini, Comte and Comtesse Brauck, Mrs. and Miss Hillfort, Mr. and Mrs. Ferrier Kerr, Captain and Miss Green.
Last night a most brilliant soiree took place at the Ladies Club. Every table in the big dining room was taken and more than a hundred guests sat down to dinner.
After dinner the talented Breton band and his wife sang some charming songs and Vendee songs in one of the smaller drawing rooms, while those more frivolously inclined danced gaily in the "salle ronde" to the inviting strains of the band.
