THE MILITARY LAW.

The fact that many of the officers of the Virginia militia disagree with Attorney-General Montague in his opinion that entering the service of the United States deprived them of their commissions to the State volunteers, has never been made prominent, but the opinion in some quarters is very strong.

Let it be stated by those who are opposed to the attorney general's views that under the terms of the entrance of Virginia volunteers into the service of the United States, they could not be regarded as quitting the service of Virginia. All officers under the volunteer army bill up to and including the rank of colonel were commissioned by the governors of the States. They could not be held to have accepted a post under the national government. When they were mustered out of the service they simply returned from detached service, and should have been ordered to rejoin their State organizations.

Those who take this view point to the action of the governor of Connecticut last week. The Third Connecticut regiment returned home Monday of last week, after being mustered out at a southern camp. On the following day the governor of the State issued an order directing that the regiment, which "had been on detached service," be again attached to the State brigade. In every other State it is claimed that this course has been followed, with possibly two or three exceptions, including Virginia.

Attorney General Montague is firmly of the opinion that he was right in the construction of the law.

"The Virginia statute is plain," he said yesterday. "Under it every officer and enlisted man of the Virginia volunteers who entered the United States army, was ipso facto, mustered out of the service of the State. If the statutes of the States in which the state troops were regarded as having been merely on detached duty are the same as that of Virginia on this subject, then all I have to say is that the law in those states has been improperly construed, in my judgment."

"However," continued Mr. Montague, "I wish the courts of this State would pass upon the question. I did not wish to assume the responsibility of deciding it and should be glad to know that the bench sustained me, which I have but little doubt it would."

Governor Tyler will, in a few days, issue his orders for the disbandment of the military and reorganization of new companies. The delay has been due to the question arising in connection with the organizations before entering the national service. Attorney General Montague was asked for an opinion as to whether the property would pass to the new organizations. He will render it in a few days.

The old First regiment had in hand when its companies were assigned to the Second and Third between \$5,000 and \$6,000, which was raised for the purpose of buying new uniforms. It is understood that trustees will be appointed to take charge of this money.

The fighting in the Philippines has aroused the martial spirit of the members of the Virginia regiments recently mustered out. Several of them have expressed a desire to enlist for service there, and should there be a call for troops they will do so. An officer-friend says he thinks three companies can be raised in Richmond without difficulty. —[Richmond Dispatch.


